Rules and Regulations for the 2010 – 2x4 Challenge: Something For A Workshop

2010 Challenge Bonus: Judges will award bonus points to all entries that consist of one or more items that could be considered “something for a workshop”.

1. **Participation in the 2010 – 2x4 Challenge is open to all amateur woodworkers within the province of British Columbia or the state of Washington.**
2. An eligible entry is an item completed within the previous 12 calendar months, which has not been previously submitted, in whole or in part, into any prior PWWG 2x4 Challenges.
3. Each participant can submit multiple entries – entries remain the property of the participant.
4. Each entry can be entered into one of three categories: novice, intermediate or expert.
5. Novice participants cannot have won previous novice, intermediate or expert categories in prior PWG 2x4 challenges.
6. Intermediate participants cannot have won previous intermediate or expert categories in prior PWG 2x4 challenges.
7. Apart from rules 1 & 2, there are no entry restrictions for the expert category.
8. For all categories, the entry must be made from a single, 8-foot length of wood, no more than 2” wide by 4” deep.
9. For all categories, the entry can be fastened using any glue and finished using any substance commonly understood to be, or that can be explained to be, a wood finish.
10. For all categories, the entry can also include one other material for decorative purposes or for a usage that cannot be replicated with wood. This material should not be the primary focus of the entry nor should it be used in a way that makes the piece larger by replacing a component that could normally be made of wood.
11. In addition to rules 8, 9 and 10, novice entries can also make use of fasteners to join the parts of the entries together.
12. **All entries must be brought to the event location between 11:00am to Noon on April 24, 2010.** A completed entry form is required for each entry. Blank entry forms will be available at the meeting. For other than current members of the PWWG, a registration fee of CAD\$10.00 must be provided along with the entry form.
13. **All entries must be brought to the meeting covered as not to disclose their nature.**
14. Each participant has up to 8 minutes to present and assemble his or her entry, describing salient project details including the nature of the project, construction challenges and any question deemed relevant by the judges.
15. Eligible judges are the PWWG members and participants present at the event.
16. After the presentation of all the entries, there will be an opportunity for judges to examine each entry and ask specific questions of each participant.
17. Judges will rate originality, craftsmanship, effectiveness (best incorporates the wood’s unique characteristics) and the entertainment value of the presentation.
18. An award will be presented to the participant of each category whose entry collects the most votes as the best project for that category.
19. An award will also be presented to the participant whose entry collects the most votes for one of the following criteria. All entries are eligible for these awards.
 - Best first-time entry
 - Best quickie project (**must have been started no sooner than April 22, 2010**)
 - Most original
 - Best craftsmanship
 - Best use of a 2x4
